HISTORY PROJECT - UPDATE

One of the 'objects' of the HMNZS Ngapona Assn is: "To encourage an interest in the history of Ngapona and maintain a permanent record".

To accomplish this it was decided that the first task would be to scan the large number of photographs held at Ngapona so that they would be preserved. It was also decided that the value of a photograph would be greatly enhanced if the people and places were also recorded. This process is now well underway and we now have a large database which holds a digital copy of the photograph and a description. Where people can be identified it includes the name, rank and service number.

This information has been drawn from a list of over 2000 names which has been compiled of persons who have served at Ngapona from 1948 to 1995. Unfortunately I have no records from 1995 to the present day. If you are able to provide any information that could assist in completing the database of persons who have served it would be most appreciated.

TENSIONS WITH IRAN

The UK Government is looking to form a European-led naval force to enhance protection to shipping assets passing through the Strait of Hormuz following tensions with Iran. The proposal to create the maritime protection mission was made by British Foreign Secretary Jeremy Hunt in a statement to the House of Commons. It comes in the wake of rising tensions in the Gulf after Iran impounded a British-flagged tanker, *STENA IMPERO*, in the Strait of Hormuz on 19 July. *STENA IMPERO* is now reportedly held at the Iranian port of Bandar Abbas.

HMS MONTROSE, a British frigate now in the area, carried out the first mission under the new policy on Wednesday evening.

DID YOU KNOW?

In 2015 the RNZN changed the colour of its ships from Waikato Grey to a new slightly darker Haze Grey colour. The new paint also uses polysiloxane components that give it improved durability and fire resistance qualities over the older polyurethane paints, and near-infrared reflecting pigments means that the temperature of the ship structure is kept lower, which assists internal cooling and IR signature.
